**On July 19, 2004 at approximately 2:30pm, a family of three marmosets was found dead inside of their nesting box after the cage was sent through the cage washer. The IACUC has investigated the situation and is addressing the issue through disciplinary actions and retraining of staff. Corrective measures are being taken to prevent future incidents from taking place.
