## FACILITIES, GENERAL.

On April 15, 2019, a two year old female black bear was shot dead by a local sheriff after it escaped from its enclosure. A power outage occurred at the facility from April 14th from about 9:00 PM until about 6:00 AM on April 15th. Two of the five bears housed in the yearling bear enclosure were able to climb out of the enclosure by scaling the 10' foot primary fence and the 8' perimeter fence. They were discovered missing at about 10:00 AM on the morning of April 15th. One bear was tranquilized and returned to its enclosure without incident. The other bear was shot by the local sheriff approximately ½ mile away. At the time of the power outage there was no emergency power generator backup for the yearling enclosure. All enclosures now have emergency power generator back up. Enclosures must be constructed and maintained to contain the animals and protect them from injury. Maintain all enclosures to contain the bears.
