- A female camel had dried blood on the back and the inner surfaces of both rear limbs, and what appeared to be puncture wounds in two locations on the back of her left rear limb. No treatment had been instituted, and there was no indication that any employees were aware of the injury. Animals must be observed daily to assess their health and wellness. This animal must be seen by a licensed veterinarian within 2 days and treated appropriately. Records must be maintained of any findings and/or treatment.
