As you probably know, buying an animal from a pet shop or breeder exacerbates the homeless-animal crisis, which costs more than 3 million cats and dogs their lives every year, and every "unfixed" dog or cat who has a litter adds to the number. Animal shelters are forced to euthanize many wonderful, deserving cats and dogs because of a lack of good homes. Every animal purchased from a breeder or pet store kills a needy animal's chance at the American dream of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, and making sure that your dog or cat is sterilized is a sign of being a caring person.

Many daters who choose adoption and offer a loving home to an abandoned cat or dog awaiting a chance at life in an animal shelter would prefer to be matched with like-minded individuals who share the same values. We hope you'll set a wonderful example by encouraging applicants with a revised questionnaire that includes this information. Please let us know if we can be of any assistance.
