Dear Ms. Zuiderveen:

I hope this letter finds you well. I'm writing to request that your office (and the proper law-enforcement agency, as you deem appropriate) investigate and file criminal charges as suitable against those responsible for depriving dogs of water, shelter, and sanitary conditions—and keeping two tethered—at a puppy mill operated by Jacob Lambright. PETA urges investigators to visit the facility with a veterinarian so that they can identify any animals in need of care and opine on the conditions of and for the animals there.

A U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) inspector documented the neglect in the attached report. On June 16, the federal agent found three collies deprived of water. The dogs drank for at least 45 seconds without stopping after Lambright provided them with water at the agent's direction. The same day, the USDA inspector found 29 dogs confined with "excessive feces." Seventeen dogs were provided just five doghouses, in which they couldn't all fit at once. One dog was tied with a "heavy chain" to two logs, while another was tethered to a fence.

The above omissions appear to violate Michigan's anti-cruelty statute, MCL § 750.50(2)(a), which requires that Lambright provide his dogs with sufficient water, doghouses of appropriate dimensions for their size, and space free of excessive waste. His tethering of these dogs may also have violated MCL § 750.50(2)(g). Action by the USDA doesn't preclude criminal liability under state law for federally licensed facilities and workers who perpetrate acts of cruelty against animals there.
