Trailer was backed up at poultry dock during lunch and REDACTED conducted an antemortem inspection at the end of lunch. upon conducting antemortem, REDACTED noticed several had already died and several more were in the process of dying. A clear count could not be determined at said time because the live turkeys were standing on top of the dead and dying. REDACTED inquired with establishment employees about dead turkeys and was informed that they were aware of the situation and they had already contacted establishment owner & Haccp Coordinator. After lunch establishment finished slaughtering the remaining 9 crates of chickens (between 81-108 birds) before starting turkey slaughter. Upon discussion with establishment owner, he stated that he believed that it was the heat and the overcrowded trailer that caused the several death. He further stated that they should have slaughtered Turkeys first before slaughtering chickens. unknown the total weight of the dead. REDACTED ensured that all DOA turkeys were removed and placed in inedible barrels and were not processed.</p>
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
