We hope to continue to steer customers seeking these products toward 99 Ranch Market. We've sent you these humanely harvested coconuts in the hope of finally *cracking open* a dialog about reconsidering your business relationship with Chaokoh, a brand implicated in a recent PETA Asia investigation into the use of monkeys kept chained for life—some with their teeth removed and many illegally taken from the forests—in Thailand's coconut industry.

PETA Asia's investigation revealed that Chaokoh is part of an industry using cruel training methods to force monkeys—often driven insane from being deprived of everything that's natural and important to them—to climb trees and knock down coconuts. More than 34,000 stores, including Albertsons, Target, Kroger, and Wegmans, have stopped selling products from Chaokoh. Luckily, plenty of brands use coconuts that were picked by willing human tree-climbers or they plant dwarf coconut trees that don't require climbing. We'd be happy to provide you with a list of the brands that don't use monkey labor.

We hope you will act swiftly to remove cruelly sourced coconut products from your shelves. **May we please hear from you soon**?
