Primary enclosures for nonhuman primates must meet the following minimum requirements:

- (a) General requirements.
- (2) Primary enclosures must be constructed and maintained so that they:
- (i) Have no sharp points or edges that could injure the nonhuman primates

\*\*\*In lab 241 there is a testing unit that has a plexiglass type material used for one of the sides. This material has cracked and split leaving an uneven surface. The split as a pointed edge which could cause injury to the nonhuman primate when contained in the enclosure. The unit shall be repaired to protect the health and well-being of the nonhuman primate. Correct by August 26, 2012.
