(f) Handling. (1) Handling of all animals shall be done as expeditiously and carefully as possible in a manner that does not cause trauma, overheating, excessive cooling, behavioral stress, physical harm, or unnecessary discomfort.

***There was an animal incident in February 2013 involving a pig. A procedure was performed on a pig involving placement of a jugular catheter. The pig was recovered and placed in an enclosure. Overnight the catheter tip became stuck in the bottom of the cage and broke off resulting in the pig bleeding to death. Animals shall be handled in a manner that will minimize the possibility of such occurrence. Corrected.
