(d) Pest control. An effective program for control of insects, external parasites affecting nonhuman primates, and birds and mammals that are pests, must be established and maintained so as to promote the health and well-being of the animals and reduce contamination by pests in animal areas.

***During the inspection of the NSB, D, and Q buildings there is evidence of insufficient pest control. There were live and dead roaches in the hallway to NSB. There are dead insects in the older style light shields in animal rooms. Dead roaches were also noted in the receptacle cover in one animal room. Although there are fly strips in the animal rooms which have been effective in trapping insects, there are numerous (too numerous to count) flies and roaches on the strips. Upon entering a procedure room there were live flies swarming in the room. A more effective pest control program should be develoed to minimize the presence of these pests in the buildings thereby reducing contamination and promoting the health and well-being of the animals.
