

Feds Sue Operator of Dog-Breeding Facility and Seize 446 Beagles

Facility Temporarily Barred by U.S. Court From Selling or Breeding Dogs

The U.S. Department of Justice and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Office of the Inspector General removed 446 dogs and puppies in "acute distress" from Envigo's beagle-breeding facility in Cumberland,

Virginia, after a PETA exposé revealed the presence of hundreds of dead puppies as well as workers with no veterinary credentials who were injecting euthanasia drugs directly into puppies' hearts without sedation.

Every animal-breeding facility investigated by PETA has been found to inflict misery—laboratory suppliers *must* be shut down. Animal experiments aren't working and aren't needed. State-of-the-art, animal-free technology is available and will modernize research.
