After a moment of not hearing anything, I peeked around at the stunning pen and observed the animal's head moving around above the gate of the stunning pen which indicated that the animal was standing and fully conscious. REDACTED indicated that he was going to shoot again so I moved back into the safe area. I heard the second shot and then heard REDACTED give the "all clear". I then observed the unconscious animal roll out of the stunning pen and it remained unconscious during sticking, bleeding, and subsequent dressing. I then observed the head after skinning and was able to see two holes approximately two inches apart in the midline of the skull. No regulatory control action was taken due to the effective corrective action that was taken by REDACTED. This is a noncompliance with 9CFR 313.16(a)(1). A search of Non-compliance Records from the past 90 days indicates that there was another unsuccessful stun on 1/19/22. REDACTED was given a copy of this noncompliance report. HATS Category III: Water and Feed Availability On March 1st, 2022, at approximately 7:30, while performing an antemortem inspection and the Livestock Humane Handling task at Est 9958, REDACTED and I, REDACTED, observed a large black water trough in pen 7 that was dry. Pen 7 contained 3 beef. There was no other accessibility to water. REDACTED was informed of the isue and he the filed the water trough with water. I observed cattle #1 slip a couple times but did not lose its footing. Then I moved to the side of the stun box. As the employees were driving them from behind into the stun box from the alleyway, I saw cattle #2 tumble forward and fall. Both animals were standing upright after the incident and did not appear to be injured or in distress. This does not meet regulatory regulation 9 CFR 313.1. REDACTED was notified of this noncompliance verbally and was given this noncompliance record.
