Dear Dr. Goldentyer:

I'm writing on behalf of People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals U.S.—PETA entities have more than 9 million members and supporters globally—to urge the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) to take swift and immediate action regarding Quebedeaux's Transport LLC's apparent continued operation without an active carrier registration. We also urge the USDA to investigate companies continuing to do business with carriers that aren't permitted by the agency to transport animals.

Quebedeaux's Transport Hauling Monkeys Without USDA Registration

Jeffrey Quebedeaux had been registered with the USDA as a Class T–Carrier under Quebedeaux's Transport LLC (72-T-0012), but as of August 11, the registration has been canceled.¹ Troublingly, it appears that the company is continuing to operate after this cancellation. According to a certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI) that PETA obtained via a public records request, on October 3 the company transported four elderly long-tailed macaques—a species listed as endangered by the International Union for Conservation of Nature—from Immokalee, Florida, to Tempe, Arizona, via truck/trailer.² BC US LLC (58-B-0628) consigned the shipment. Arizona State University accepted the shipment of monkeys, with the intention of using them in experiments.

Quebedeaux's Transport Also Violating Out-of-Service Order

As we previously notified APHIS, Quebedeaux's Transport LLC also violated an out-of-service (OOS) order from the Department of Transportation's Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA). On March 19, the FMCSA issued an OOS order to Quebedeaux's Transport, USDOT number 3591967, for refusing a safety audit.³ It's our understanding that while under this OOS order, the company isn't authorized to do business.

Nevertheless, Quebedeaux's Transport's trucks continued to operate while under the OOS order. Through Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests to multiple states* for CVIs that include nonhuman primates—which, as you know, are required documents for monkeys transported across state lines—PETA discovered that Quebedeaux's Transport had apparently violated the OOS order on the following occasions:

^{*}Not every CVI that PETA reviewed lists the name of the transportation company, and several FOIA requests submitted within this time frame are pending fulfillment. We have no mechanism for determining all the shipments that Quebedeaux's Transport may have handled since March 19.

Quebedeaux's Transport is currently listed as "inactive" in the FMCSA's Safety and Fitness Electronic Records System. PETA has also submitted a complaint to the FMCSA.

Quebedeaux's History of Recklessness and Breaking the Law

As noted in our July 27 correspondence, another company owned by Quebedeaux—the Dr. William Greer Foundation—recently drew the attention of officials in Louisiana after he attempted to retrofit a prison to serve as a quarantine and holding facility for monkeys. The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries issued multiple cease-and-desist letters for violations of Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 76 § 115(C)(1), which prohibits the possession of nonhuman primates with exceptions for accredited zoos and registered research facilities. He attempted to acquire a research registration from the USDA but was denied. On September 20, local officials initiated eviction proceedings against him and the collection of many months of unpaid rent. The company currently has a Class H–Intermediate Handler USDA registration under the Dr. William Greer Foundation LLC (72-H-0016).

As you know, earlier this year a Quebedeaux's Transport pickup truck hauling a trailer containing 100 long-tailed macaques collided with another vehicle outside Danville, Pennsylvania. Dozens of wooden crates holding the beleaguered monkeys were propelled out of the truck and onto a highway. Several monkeys escaped, and authorities confirmed that three had

been shot and killed. This crash wasn't the company's first reckless incident. In 2020, Quebedeaux's Transport was involved in an incident in New Jersey in which a truck hauling monkeys caught fire. In addition, the USDA issued Stone Oaks Farm and Transports—Quebedeaux's previous transportation company—an official warning for violating the federal Animal Welfare Act (AWA) following the death in 2011 of a chimpanzee the company was transporting to a laboratory.

Request: Immediate Investigation and Penalties

PETA has alerted the USDA to problems with Quebedeaux's businesses a few times this year, but as of this writing, no inspection reports have been posted for any of his businesses since 2019 and it appears that no action has been taken. This latest instance by Quebedeaux's Transport of shipping vulnerable, elderly monkeys across the U.S. without licensure from the USDA or the FMCSA is extremely concerning, and we urge you to launch an immediate investigation into the company as well as BC US and Arizona State University for their roles in the shipment. If your investigation finds violations, we ask that you not only send a clear message that scofflaw companies that seek to conceal their operations and fail to comply with the minimum requirements of the AWA undermine public trust and safety but also issue the maximum penalty fines afforded by law.

I appreciate your attention to this important matter. I look forward to hearing from you.

Dear Mr. Quebedeaux:

The Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) is in receipt of August, 17, 2022, email, and attachments thereto, which include the August 2, 2022, Cease and Desist letter to you from LDWF and a photograph attachment of a letter from Elizabeth Goldentyer, D.V.M., Deputy Administrator of the USDA, APHIS, denying your application for a research facility designation.

LDWF appreciates your effort to communicate and acknowledgement of receipt of our Cease and Desist letter. However, this office is concerned that you might misunderstand the current posture of this situation.

Please be advised that the Cease and Desist letter remains effective. As this office has explained to you in the past, the only way in which you may have been exempt from state regulations regarding the possession of nonhuman primates was by obtaining the "research facility" designation through the USDA. Based upon the letter from USDA that you have forwarded to this office, the facility at issue would not meet the definition of a research facility, and your application for that designation was denied.

Further, there is no other recourse for you or your business entities to lawfully house nonhuman primates in the State of Louisiana. To be clear, even if you were granted a Class B license from the USDA, you would not be exempt from applicable state laws and regulations, prohibiting the importation, possession, purchase or selling of nonhuman primates. As such, in order for you to legally house nonhuman primates in Louisiana, you and your facility would need to meet the criteria of another regulatory category under L.A.C. 76:V.115 that would allow for such activities while under the regulatory authority of LDWF. Our review of the pertinent regulations indicates that no such alternative exists.

In short, your proposed facility is not exempt from the prohibition of possession of nonhuman primates, and the possession of nonhuman primates in Louisiana remains unlawful.

RE: Notice of unpermitted proposed activity involving non-human primates

Dear Mr. Quebedeaux:

This letter is intended to provide notice to you and the William Greer Foundation, L.L.C., that the proposed facility located at 7807 Hwy. 115 in Bunkie, Louisiana is currently unpermitted to house non-human primates, and housing such animals there would be in violation of state law and regulations.

On June 14, 2022, upon learning about a proposed facility that would house non-human primates, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) Enforcement agents conducted an inspection on Avoyelles Parish School Board property located at 7807 Hwy. 115 Bunkie, LA. Access to the premises was granted and accompanied by an Avoyelles Parish School Board employee and an onsite security guard.

During the inspection, LDWF agents observed numerous cages and workers constructing new cinder block structures in an outside courtyard area. Upon information gathered at the site and through interviews with you and veterinarian Dr. Marsha Mouliere, LDWF agents confirmed that you plan to house several hundred monkeys shipped from Asia at the facility.

Be advised that, except in limited instances, possession of non-human primates (monkeys and apes) in the State of Louisiana is unlawful and prohibited under LAC Title 76: 115 (C)(1), which provides, in pertinent part:

C.1. Except as provided herein, it shall be unlawful to import into, possess, purchase or sell within the state of Louisiana, by any means whatsoever including but not limited to transactions conducted via the internet, any of the following species or its subspecies of live wild quadrupeds, big exotic cats, or non-human primates, domesticated or otherwise (hereinafter "listed animals"):

* * *

g. all non-human primates;

Although LAC Title 76:115 (E) provides certain exceptions¹ to the general rule that the possession of non-human primates is prohibited, LDWF records indicate that, with possible exception to the transport of such animals, neither you nor the business entities with which you are associated (i.e., the William Greer Foundation, L.L.C.) are permitted to possess non-human primates in the State of Louisiana. Further, you do not possess a research facility license issued by the USDA under United States Code title 7, chapter 54, §2132(e), nor do you meet the other exemptions referenced above.

As such, the possession of non-human primates at the proposed facility would be a violation of LA. R.S. 56:6(31), R.S. 56:115, R.S. 56:171, and R.S. 56:1904(F) and the rules promulgated thereunder (L.A.C. Ch. 76:V.1. §115). Under penalty of law, LDWF strongly urges you to cease your proposed activities involving the possession and housing of non-human primates at the facility mentioned herein.
