Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

The facility did not have records demonstrating any of the acquisition information for the birds currently on-hand. An Umbrella cockatoo, 2 Kookaburra, 1 Keel-billed toucan, 2 ducks, 3 chickens, 1 Eclectus parrot, 1 Shamrock macaw, and 60 Parakeets were listed on the facilities acquisition paperwork but name, address, and date acquired had not been filled out. Complete and accurate animal records must be kept in order to facilitate tracing of animals in the event of an animal disease outbreak. Records must be maintained that fully and correctly disclose information concerning all covered animals purchased or otherwise acquired, owned, held, leased, transported, sold, euthanized or otherwise disposed of and shall include any offspring born while in the licensee's possession.

Facilities, general.

There were approximately 3 bottles of cleaning solution stored adjacent and beneath a shelf in the bird food preparation area. Spillage of toxic substances in food preparation areas represents a potential risk to the health and welfare of the animals. Substances, such as cleaning supplies, that are harmful to the birds, but required for normal husbandry practices, must not be in food storage and preparation areas. These substances may be stored in cabinets in the animal areas, provided they are stored in properly labeled containers that are adequately secured to prevent potential harm to the birds.

3.153(a)(1)(ii)

Primary enclosures.

The primary enclosure of a kookaburra had an open electrical socket inside its primary enclosure. The socket was along the top edge of a back wall and a light fixture was plugged into 1 of the 2 sockets but the other was exposed within reach of the bird. The bird was observed flying around the enclosure, and therefore had access to the electrical socket. An open electrical socket cord could cause potential harm to the bird. The primary enclosure must be constructed and maintained
