All life on Earth is in jeopardy if meat production is not curtailed. And every animal is some*one*, not some*thing*, with their own unique personality and perspective. If we hope to be enlightened individuals, we must see animals for who they are, and to help with that, we're sending you a copy of PETA's new Empathy Kit (a digital version can be downloaded here) to read and share with your family. We hope you'll conclude that the cows you plan to slaughter and put into your stomach are individuals who feel love, grief, pain, joy, and fear and who value their lives just as you value yours.

Perhaps it's not callousness—perhaps you don't know that cows mourn the deaths of their loved ones and shed actual tears when they suffer the loss of someone they care about. They're devoted mothers who form deep bonds with their calves, and their calves with them. Mother cows cry out in despair after their young are taken away and sold to veal or beef farms. We assume that you care about *your* children, too, so we urge you to think about this same love and scrap this project, which teaches them all the wrong lessons about animals and normalizes violence and exploitation.

Please also consider the planet your daughters will inherit: Study after study confirms that raising and killing animals is an environmental catastrophe. The U.N. states that a global shift toward vegan eating is *vital* to combating the worst effects of the climate crisis, and we know that eating vegan foods is the best thing anyone can do for animals, the environment, and their own health.
