you have the right to

refuse to dissect animals

in California?

It's true! Each year, countless animals (including frogs, cats, and birds) are cruelly killed and then cut up in classrooms across the country—even though humane methods exist. Studies have shown that students who use humane dissection methods perform just as well as—and often better than—students who cut up animals. You don't have to dissect! Explain to your teacher that you won't and that a law gives you the right to say NO to doing so in California. This is what it says:

Cal. Educ. Code § 32255-32255.6 (1988)

[A]ny [public school] pupil with a moral objection to dissecting or otherwise harming or destroying animals, or any parts thereof, shall notify his or her teacher regarding this objection, upon notification by the school of his or her rights The alternative education project shall require a comparable time and effort investment by the pupil. It shall not, as a means of penalizing the pupil, be more arduous than the original education project.
