in Ontario?

It's true! Each year, countless animals (including frogs, cats, and birds) are cruelly killed and then cut up in classrooms across the country—even though humane methods exist. Studies have shown that students who use humane dissection methods perform just as well as—and often better than—students who cut up animals. You don't have to dissect! Explain to your teacher that you won't and that a curriculum guide gives you the right to say NO to doing so in Ontario. This is what it says:

## The Ontario Science Curriculum Grades 11 and 12

[S]tudents will ... perform a laboratory or computer-simulated dissection of a mammal to identify organs, and explain the relationships between the structures and functions of body systems.
