you have the right to

refuse to dissect animals

in Rhode Island?

It's true! Each year, countless animals (including frogs, cats, and birds) are cruelly killed and then cut up in classrooms across the country—even though humane methods exist. Studies have shown that students who use humane dissection methods perform just as well as—and often better than—students who cut up animals. You don't have to dissect! Explain to your teacher that you won't and that a law gives you the right to say NO to doing so in Rhode Island. This is what it says:

R.I. Stat. § 16-22-20 (1997)

(a) A parent(s) or legal guardian of any student in a public or nonpublic primary or secondary school may refuse to allow their child to dissect or vivisection any vertebrate or invertebrate animal, or any part of a vertebrate or invertebrate animal. ...

(c) A teacher shall not discriminate against a student for not participating in dissection or vivisection and shall not lower a grade because a student's parent or legal guardian has chosen an alternative education project.
