#### Housing facilities, general.

On July 26, 2023, an almost 3-month-old male rhesus macaque was found loose inside one of the indoor animal housing rooms having sustained a fracture to his right arm. The arm was surgically amputated under anesthesia, just above the elbow, to facilitate a rapid recovery and return to the dam as well as the social group. The facility's internal investigation concluded that the infant got out of the cage through a square hole, approximately 3 inches long by 3 inches wide, a standard caging feature used to access food from the attached feeding bin at the front of the cage. This enclosure did not properly contain the infant allowing for the subsequent escape and injury. Housing facilities for non-human primates must be designed to contain the animals securely and protect them from injury. At the time of inspection, corrective actions and preventative measures had been implemented.

This inspection and exit interview were conducted with facility representatives.
