OFFICIAL NOTICE OF 21 DAY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE 74-C-1155

Dear Mr. [REDACTED]:

I write to notify you that your license (74-C-1155) under the Animal Welfare Act (7 U.S.C. § 2131 et seq.) (AWA or Act) is hereby suspended for a period of 21 days effective upon receipt of this letter, pursuant to section 2149(A) of the Act.

We are taking this action because we have reason to believe that you have willfully violated sections 2.131(c)(1) and 2.132(d) of the regulations issued under the AWA (9 C.F.R. Part 2) (Regulations), and failed to meet the minimum standards for animals (9 C.F.R. Part 3) (Standards), specifically, sections 3.75(a), 3.84(d), and 3.125(a).

Our evidence shows that between August 25, 2025 and December 31, 2025, during public exhibition, you failed to

- handle animals so there was minimal risk of harm to the animal and to the public with sufficient distance and/or barriers between the animal and the general viewing public so as to assure the safety of animals and the public, 9 C.F.R. § 2.131(c)(1),
- obtain animals from sources permitted by the regulations, 9 C.F.R. § 2.132(d),
- ensure housing facilities are maintained in good repair and protect animals from injury, 9 C.F.R. § 3.75(a) and 3.125(a), and
- establish an effective program for pest control, 9 C.F.R. § 3.84(d).

If you wish to appeal this suspension of your license, you may apply to the Deputy Administrator, in writing, with justification for reinstatement of your license prior to the conclusion of the 21-day suspension. 9 C.F.R. § 2.10(a).

Please know that during your suspension period, you must not buy, sell, transport, exhibit, or deliver for transportation, any AWA-regulated animal. 9 C.F.R. § 2.10(c). This prohibition applies to you, and to any employee, agent, or other person, acting on your behalf. Failure to comply with this prohibition may subject you to sanctions authorized by the Act. 7 U.S.C. § 2149.
